## Attendance and holidays - Important information

It's coming round to holiday season again. Just a reminder that, following Government advice, we will not authorise any planned absence, unless circumstances are exceptional. Unauthorised holidays are always followed up with referrals to the Education Welfare Service. This is all detailed in the Attendance policy which is available from our website.

We are aiming to be the best we can be! To be the best we must now reduce the number of children with less than 90% attendance. Did you know that if your child's attendance is 90% this is the same as your child missing half a day a week! 1 school year at 90% is the same as missing 4 whole weeks of school. Please contact us if you need help and advice around your child's attendance.

Attendance is improving but what about getting to school on time? We need all children to be in school by

8.55am. 5 minutes late each day means 25 minutes lost per week.
