Looks Like Summer is Here

Dear Parents/carers

It looks like Summer is finally here! As you know the children will be out at playtimes, dinnertimes, PE times and at other times and it is recommended that children should have any skin open to the sun covered with sun protection cream, especially if we have very hot and sunny weather. As the staff in school are unable put cream on children, it is a good idea for you to put this on before children come to school. Also we encourage you to send a hat to school so children can cover their heads, especially at the hottest times of the day. Please also make sure children have the correct tee shirt for PE and not vest tops which expose shoulders to the sun. Children will need their PE kits and sandshoes every day now as they will be taking part in many PE activities especially now the weather is better. Please ensure that your child's sandshoes are still suitable as some children have now outgrown them.

Behaviour Before School

We have had some complaints from parents of the behaviour of some of our children before school. We have spoken to the children in school but please could you remind your child as well so that all children feel safe. We do open the doors 5 minutes before school time so that children are in school earlier. Children are allowed to play on the field in the morning before school if the grass is dry.

Uniform

Please can you ensure children are in uniform-white polo shirt, black or grey school long or short trousers, school sweatshirt or cardigan, school dress blue and white check or yellow and white check. No jogging bottoms. Classes are going out on trips this term and will be representing the school. We want everyone to see how smart our children are.
