Children who are moving into Foundation 2 in September will move into their new classes as well. Drop them off at the F1 and then they can be picked up at the F2 doors just along the path. Your children may stay for the full week and be dropped off at 8.55am and picked up at 3.10pm. If you have difficulties with this just let the office know before the 18th July. If your child is going to stay full days please give them a packed lunch each day.

All other children will be coming out of the appropriate doors. If your children are going to be in Year 1 or 2 they will come out of the doors to the right of the building. If they are going to be in Years 3 or 4 they will be come out of the yellow doors at the back of the building. If your children are going to be in Year 5 or 6 they can be met at the front yellow doors to the left of the building. The children who are in Year 6 now and who haven't gone to Sirius Academy, will come in and go out as normal. From Tuesday of that week all children will enter and leave from their new classes.

This will help children to get ready for their new classes and meet their new teachers before September so that on our first day back on Monday 5th September they will already feel happy knowing where they are going.
