Our Values Based Curriculum

Just a reminder of our house system which is based on the values parents/carers valued most for their children. Each child is allocated to a house and siblings are in the same house. Each of our 6 school houses has a value attached to it: Pickering-Kindness; Wilberforce-Tolerance; Ferens-Politeness; Sullivan-Respect; Billocca-Honesty and Johnson-Responsibility. Children get house points for a variety of reasons and these are added up each week. The house with the most points is rewarded each term. Ask your child how their house is doing.

Our school uniform is part of our values. Children belong to the school and they respect the school's values and are proud to wear their badge. So we expect children to be smart and wear our uniform. Thank you parents and carers for making sure your children are looking very smart and proud in their school uniforms at the start of the Autumn term. As they are ready to get those to you as soon as possible.
