#### **Holidays in Term Time**

The Government advice to schools about fining parents/carers for taking term time holidays is that they expect schools to continue to fine parents/carers. The DFE states that the recent legal findings in the Isle of Wight where the judge said that 90% attendance was satisfactory, was wrong, as the DFE state that 96% attendance is only average and that any time taken for holidays in school time is detrimental to a child's education.
