#### School Uniforms -Rawcliffe's

Our school uniform is part of our values. Children belong to the school and they respect the school's values and are proud to wear their badge. So we expect children to be smart and wear our uniform. Thank you parents and carers for making sure your children are looking very smart and proud in their school uniforms at the start of the Autumn term. Just a reminder: no jeans or tracksuit bottoms please, even if they are black they are not uniform; no leggings only socks or tights; white polo shirts only; all children must have sandshoes for indoor use. F2 need sandshoes for PE. As you know, Y6 have a different uniform, being the oldest in the school. They wear a V-necked school jumper with logo, a white long sleeved shirt and a school tie. I know that some of you are having real difficulties regarding your uniform orders from our old suppliers, CS Enterprises. It is very annoying for you and I sympathise as we were not aware that this was going to happen. Our new provider is now Rawcliffe's in the town centre. Their website link is on our website. If you have ordered uniform, and not paid for it yet, please cancel the order. If you have paid for your order and the money has been taken from your account, but you have not received your order, then please let the school know.

### Homework

This is usually given out on a Friday and expected back for Tuesday. Children can ask for help on a Monday if they are struggling. Don't forget children are expected to read at home at least 5 times in a week and they must bring their school reading book back to school.

#### PE

Your child's teacher will let you know when their PE session is or you can find our PE timetable on our website under Our School > The School Day. It is quite a good idea for your child to leave their PE kit in school for the half term then they will not forget it when they need it. Then at half term it can be taken home to wash.

### **Attendance**

Don't forget the school does not authorise holidays in school time and we do fine parents for taking children out of school unless there are unavoidable extreme circumstances which the school may authorise. Remember school
