


How can you check there are always 5?</p>	<p>Get 2 bags and put a handful of stones in each one. Which bag do you think has more? Pick them up, does that give you a clue? Take the stones out of the bag and find out which one has more. Remember to line the stones from each bag up, how do you know which has more?</p>	<p>Let's play musical statues. Ask your grown up to play some music, when they stop the music get them to show you a number card. Show your grown up the different ways to make that number using your fingers.</p>	<p>Make some number cards 1-5. Chose 2 and compare the quantity by using objects. Which has more? Which has less? How can you make the numbers equal?</p>	<p>Can you draw a ladybird with more spots than mine?</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>
