- ✓ ...create a simple map of the school grounds (or home) and learn compass directions.
- ✓ ...describe some physical (natural) and human (man-made) features in the environment around us.
- ✓ ...name and locate the four countries in the UK and our capital city.
- ✓ ...name the waters that surround the UK.
- ✓ ...identify the equator and north and south poles on a globe.

As Historians we will...

- ✓ ...learn about famous people in Hull such as William Wilberforce and explain why they are famous.

Key vocabulary: past, present, before, after, then, now,

As scientists we will...

- ✓ ... explore which parts of our bodies help us to see, hear, smell, taste and feel.
- ✓ ...describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals).
- ✓ ...group animals according to what they eat.
