Vocabulary –

Belonged - (belong, belongs) Explain the meaning within the context of the story: Dogger belonged to Dave. If something ‘belongs’ to you, it is yours.

Fond - Explain the meaning within the context of the story: Dave was very fond of Dogger. ‘Fond’ means you really like something.

Anxiously - Explain the meaning within the context of the story: Dave watched anxiously while his family searched for Dogger. ‘Anxiously’ means you are worried about something
