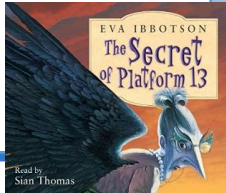


As readers we will...

- ✓ Produce a report about The Arctic Fox
- ✓ Write a narrative about Echo and Narcissus
- ✓ Look at poetry through the use of Dreams of Escape

- ✓ describe the characteristics of different states of matter and group materials on this basis
- ✓ explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment.
